

What a difference a year makes! We were thrown a world-wide curve ball meant to strike us out, but with God's help and your faith, we swung the bat, hit the ball, and ran the bases! Covid-19 did not win. My verse through this is from Paul's heart and his writing to the Philippian church... "but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus!" (3:13)

Thank you, pastors, staff, volunteers, and churches, for pressing on in faith! We don't know what the future holds, but by faith, I know Christ will be in it! This year we came back together! We celebrated the PBA ministry at New Hope with a tremendous gathering of our brothers and sisters! The youth came together for TNT at Hillcrest for a soul stirring testimony from Cary Sanders. Operation Care continued to serve as volunteers went in and out in all weather. Operation Care gave me the opportunity to talk and pray with 134 people who have terrible circumstances to deal with. Three of those made professions of faith! PTL. Only God knows how many others prayed privately to be saved! The Christian Learning Center is active with Jr. High kids studying the word of God taught by Mrs. Joan Moody. And new this year, Waycross Baptist Church and Pastor Dickie McCuen took on Woodmont Middle CLC giving those students the place to study the Bible off campus! This year we restarted the Sunday School Clinic planned by Rev. Ryan Steed with 48 in attendance! PTL!

Finally, this year, I challenged our churches to reach out to South East Asia in a year we could Not Travel! On November 2, 2021 PBA mailed a check for \$14,557.08 to the IMB to be designated to two islands in the South Pacific for the purchase of water filter pots, training of young national evangelists, and opening of doors for churches to be planted in villages we could never get to otherwise! Praise God! I must add this special note of thanks to Riverside Baptist and Pastor Ryan Steed; they collected and gave \$6,000 alone to this mission effort! From the children's Sunday School Classes at Washington Baptist Church to individuals who saw this vision, I say THANK YOU! The funds have already been sent to the field and on November 14th the first pots began to be distributed.

Dear Pastors of Palmetto Baptist Association,

Greetings from SEast Asia! First of all, I want to express my heartfelt thanks for your generosity in giving your contribution to Sharon's and Shelly's and my work here in SEA. Although Sharon is working on a different island than we do (Sulawesi) she and I are working together with my CH here in Central Java to start a new work in the area of Central Sulawesi.

In addition to that, we are focused on our Unreached People Group here in Central Java (Pantura UPG). We have been focused in on them for almost 20 years of ministry. M.J did a good job in developing the Water Filter Ministry as he worked with the Impact Center and North Coast Java team to distribute them in the area in order to build and establish relationships with people that do not know Christ, so we can build on those relationships and share the Good News of Jesus with hundreds of people.

With the McVey family taking a Leave of Absence, we have been asked to continue that ministry among the North Coast Javanese and in turn use those Water Filters you helped purchase to open up doors to share the Good News of Jesus Christ. We will periodically send you photos of Water Filter Distributions and also give reports about sharing the Gospel
