PBA Missions for June & July

Operation Care: Kid Friendly Food Items for the Summer. Macaroni & cheese, grits, soup, crackers, Jell-O cups, pudding cups, Kool-Aid, tea, sugar, jelly, peanut butter, cereals, cereal bars, canned meats, canned vegetables, canned fruits, snacks, etc. Pop-top lids are great for the kids. Refrigerated and freezer foods are welcome too, and don't forget the summer garden veggies! Baby foods and all baby products are needed. Items such as toothpaste, shampoo, soap, tissue paper, paper towels, and cleaning products can be donated as well. Operation Care is grateful for all donations.

<u>School Supplies</u>: Yes, school is out for the summer and it's never too early to start collecting for the new year. Make this a VBS challenge "mission" for your kids.

Elementary School items: crayons (16 per box), glue sticks, loose-leaf notebook paper (wide rule), composition notebooks (single & 3 subjects), folders with three prongs and pockets, children's scissors, pencils, pencil boxes, markers, Kleenex tissue, hand sanitizer, and Book-bags.

High & Middle School: loose-leaf notebook paper (college rule), subject dividers, pencils, pencil pouches, pens, highlighters, folders with prongs, Kleenex, and hand sanitizer. Book-bags and lunch boxes are needed for both schools.

<u>Care Bag Items:</u> consists of soap, shampoo, hair conditioner, toothpaste, tooth brush, deodorant, etc. Unopened hotel soaps, shampoos, and lotions can be saved for the Care Bag Ministry. Items are used at local schools for children in need.
