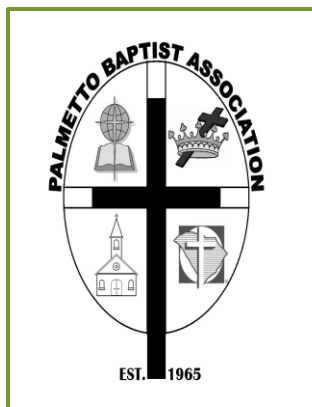

One was a 56-year-old black guy who told me “no one has ever explained it to me like that before!” I've had the opportunity through 13 years of this ministry, to hear 45 people from several races come to Christ in and out of the lobby. Many others who volunteer had encounters in real time with people who needed more than food. I appreciate all who give their spare time to make Christ known. A special thanks to Jimny Bryant for loading, hauling, and unloading at Operation Care and the Back Packing room! PBA church members from five churches came to the Williamston Park to invite passersby to their church and share Christ with them. Bill West, our PBA EV Director has two professions of faith while sharing around the area. Big Creek's folks are giving clothes to hundreds of men, women, and children along with a hug and a witness. PBA ladies from several of our sister churches pack weekend bags for five elementary schools to feed 250+ kids per weekend! (A huge lift by faith!) God provides each month for this expensive ministry of love. Call Beverly Adkins for information. Tabernacle Baptist continues to reach out to many trapped in drug addiction. Hillcrest builds ramps around the south in Jesus' name! Cedar Grove and Whitefield churches “knock on doors” reaching many for Jesus! Pastor Ryan Steed provides the “BEST” associational Sunday School clinic in SC! Another is one coming in September. Joel Lopez did a great job at TnT! The children's event planned by Dianna Murphy and team was a huge success! The PBA WMU led by Annette Drake and Ashley Steed are off and running! Open Door Fellowship has “opened her doors” to the Hispanic ministry. I could go on and on! A BIG thanks to all!

This June, we will be sending a team of our pastors to Panama on a vision trip to work alongside the McVeys who are IMB workers there. They will discover opportunities for our Churches to return there and go “On Mission” for Christ. (Hey, it's a four-hour flight!) I'll be asking our churches to “pitch in” to help with the expenses of the trip for the group. I'm calling them the “Fabulous Four!” A return trip is planned for October 2026. Pray for and about that. Lastly, in the next two weeks I will deliver to all our pastors a “Who's Your One” kit to help guide our folks to join in with the NAMB nationwide plan to help members find, pray for, and win one soul to Jesus this year. Listen for your opportunity to participate. It's a terrific idea! There are so many ways for you to be involved and little space here to tell you.
